1. Overview

Which guide do I need? This guide covers **automatic data feeds** — connecting ScanIt Parts to your manufacturer so shipment data pulls in on its own. If you want to *manually* upload a packing slip or invoice PDF you already have, see the *Manufacturer Data Import Guide* instead.

ScanIt Parts can pull shipment data, invoices, and order statuses directly from your manufacturer. This lets you compare what was shipped vs. what you scanned. Setup is a one-time process per manufacturer.

ScanIt Parts supports 15+ OEM manufacturers — Ford, GM, Toyota, Honda, Chrysler/Stellantis, Mercedes-Benz, BMW, Hyundai, Kia, Nissan, Lexus, Infiniti, Isuzu, Subaru, VW, and more. AC Delco and Motorcraft data pulls happen daily with no setup needed.

Go to **Manufacturer Data** in the left menu on the web dashboard and select the **Automatic** tab. Select **Add Manufacturer** to begin.

Each manufacturer has a different setup process:

Manufacturer	Credentials Needed	Extra Steps
GM	Dealer #, Username, Password	None
Honda	None	Authorize in Honda iN portal
Chrysler / Stellantis	None	Parts Manager contacts PDC
Mercedes-Benz	None	Parts Manager contacts PDC
AC Delco	None (automatic)	None — daily auto-pull
Motorcraft	None (automatic)	None — daily auto-pull

Tip: This is a one-time setup. Once connected, data flows on its own. You only come back here to update credentials or add a new manufacturer.

2. GM (GlobalConnect)

- 1 Go to **Manufacturer Data** in the left menu and select the **Automatic** tab
- 2 Select **Add Manufacturer**
- 3 Choose **GM GlobalConnect** from the Type dropdown
- 4 Enter your GM GlobalConnect Dealer Number, Username, and Password
- 5 Select **Save**

Important: The GM login you enter **MUST** have access to shipments and invoices in GlobalConnect. If the login only has access to ordering, data pulls will fail. Check with your GM rep if unsure.

Tip: After saving, use **Force Pull** to test the connection right away. If data comes back, you are set. If not, double-check your credentials.

3. Honda (iN Authorization)

Honda setup has two parts. First, add it in ScanIt Parts. Then, authorize it in the Honda iN portal.

3.1 Part 1 — ScanIt Parts

- 1 Go to **Manufacturer Data** in the left menu and select the **Automatic** tab
- 2 Select **Add Manufacturer**
- 3 Choose **Honda Site** from the Type dropdown
- 4 No username or password needed. Select **Save**

3.2 Part 2 — Honda iN Portal

- 5 Log in to **www.in.honda.com**
- 6 Enter your Dealer Number
- 7 Select **iN Plus Realtime**
- 8 Go to the **Parts** tab
- 9 Select the **Parts Invoice** section at the bottom
- 10 Select **Yes** to Activate Parts Invoice. The dropdown should show **IPS**

Select **Submit**

Note: It may take 24 to 48 hours for Honda data to start flowing after you activate.

4. Chrysler / Stellantis

- 1 Go to [Manufacturer Data](#) in the left menu and select the **Automatic** tab
- 2 Select **Add Manufacturer**
- 3 Choose **Chrysler Site** from the Type dropdown
- 4 No username or password needed. Select **Save**
- 5 Your Parts Manager must contact their Facing PDC and ask them to add the email: **Chrysler@scanitparts.com** to your dealer account

Important: Data will not flow until the PDC adds the email address. This step must be done by your Parts Manager through the Chrysler/Stellantis PDC. IPS cannot do this for you.

5. Mercedes-Benz

- 1 Go to [Manufacturer Data](#) in the left menu and select the **Automatic** tab
- 2 Select **Add Manufacturer**
- 3 Choose **Mercedes-Benz Site** from the Type dropdown
- 4 No username or password needed. Select **Save**

5 Your Parts Manager must contact their Facing PDC and ask them to add the email: **mercedesbenz@scanitparts.com** to your dealer account

Note: Same process as Chrysler. The PDC must add the email before data starts flowing.

6. Automatic Pulls (AC Delco & Motorcraft)

GM and Ford dealers get automatic daily data pulls for AC Delco and Motorcraft parts. ScanIt Parts pulls this data on its own — no setup needed.

These auto-pull items:

- Pull barcode data daily from AC Delco (GM) and Motorcraft (Ford)
- Show up in the Lookup list on the web
- **Cannot be edited or deleted**
- Stay in sync with GM and Ford

Tip: Auto-pulls also feed the Lookup system. When a new AC Delco or Motorcraft UPC is added by the manufacturer, it shows up in your lookups on its own.

7. Maintenance

After setup, manage your manufacturer connections from the [Manufacturer Data](#) page.

7.0 Reading the Automatic Dashboard

The [Manufacturer Data > Automatic](#) tab shows a row for each connected manufacturer. Each row has three columns:

Column	What It Shows
Last Attempt	When IPS last tried to pull your data. Any error or timing note appears here.
Data Arrived	When new data actually came in from the manufacturer.
Status	How fresh the data is — whether the connection is current or needs attention.

Tip: If Last Attempt is recent but Data Arrived is older, that is normal. It means the pull ran but nothing had changed since the last one. The manufacturer simply had no new data to send.

7.1 Force Pull

Pulls manufacturer data right now instead of waiting for the next automatic pull. Use this to:

- Test a new connection right after setup
- Get the latest data before reconciling a shipment
- Confirm that credentials still work

1 Go to [Manufacturer Data](#) and select the **Automatic** tab

2 Find the manufacturer and select **Force Pull**

7.2 Edit

Update dealer numbers or login credentials. Use this when passwords change or a dealer number is updated.

1 Go to [Manufacturer Data](#) and select the **Automatic** tab

2 Find the manufacturer and select **Edit**

3 Make your changes and select **Save**

7.3 Delete

Remove a manufacturer connection entirely. Use this if you no longer need data from that manufacturer.

1 Go to [Manufacturer Data](#) and select the **Automatic** tab

2 Find the manufacturer and select **Delete**

3 Confirm the deletion

Important: AC Delco and Motorcraft auto-pulls cannot be edited or deleted. Only manually added manufacturers can be changed.

8. Troubleshooting

Problem	Fix
GM data pull returns nothing	Check that your GM login has access to shipments and invoices in GlobalConnect, not just ordering.
Honda data not flowing	Wait 24-48 hours after activation. If still nothing, check that the IPS dropdown shows in Honda iN > Parts Invoice.
Chrysler data not flowing	The PDC has not added Chrysler@scanitparts.com yet. Have your Parts Manager follow up with the PDC.
Mercedes data not flowing	The PDC has not added mercedesbenz@scanitparts.com yet. Have your Parts Manager follow up with the PDC.
Force Pull fails	Credentials may have changed. Edit the manufacturer and re-enter the login details.
Cannot edit or delete a manufacturer	AC Delco and Motorcraft are auto-pulls. They cannot be changed.
Added wrong manufacturer type	Delete it and add again with the correct type from the dropdown.

9. Quick Reference

Add a Manufacturer

Manufacturer Data > Automatic > Add Manufacturer > Choose Type > Enter Credentials (if needed) > Save

Force Pull

Manufacturer Data > Automatic > Find Manufacturer > Force Pull

Edit a Manufacturer

Manufacturer Data > Automatic > Find Manufacturer > Edit > Update > Save

Delete a Manufacturer

Manufacturer Data > Automatic > Find Manufacturer > Delete > Confirm

Setup by Manufacturer

Manufacturer	Steps
GM	Add GM GlobalConnect > Enter dealer#, user, password > Save
Honda	Add Honda Site > Save > Go to www.in.honda.com > Activate Parts Invoice for IPS
Chrysler	Add Chrysler Site > Save > Parts Manager tells PDC to add Chrysler@scanitparts.com
Mercedes	Add Mercedes-Benz Site > Save > Parts Manager tells PDC to add mercedesbenz@scanitparts.com
AC Delco	No setup — automatic daily pull
Motorcraft	No setup — automatic daily pull
